Artistic Director

Retired after serving 16 years at Zanesville High School as band director and music department coordinator from 1988-2004. At ZHS, Jeff was in charge of the concert band, wind ensemble, jazz band and pep band in addition to the marching band, which had an unbroken record of 16 appearances at state finals. Previously Jeff held band director positions at Philo HS, Hamlin (WVA) HS, and Fort Frye HS. Earned Bachelors Degree at Ohio University in 1974, Masters Degree in Music Education at Marshall University in 1981, and a Masters Degree in Public School Administration at Ohio University in 1992. He has served the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) in many capacities, having held district offices of secretary/treasurer, president-elect, and president; hosting high school large group, middle school solo & ensemble, regional orchestra, local marching band, and district honor band/choir events. His professional organizations include OMEA, American School Band Directors Association, Phi Beta Mu, Omicron Delta Kappa, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Jeff was director of the Muskingum College Spirit Band 2004-2006, and currently directs the Coshocton County Community Band. He resides in Dresden with his wife, Jennifer.

Janine Schmelzer Bock - Assistant Conductor

Ms. Schmelzer Bock is a native of Bremen, OH and received her Bachelor of Music Education and Master of the Arts degrees from The Ohio State University. Her claim to fame is being the first woman to dot the 'i' in the Script Ohio Marching maneuver in a single script at a home football game.

Her teaching career started at Philo H.S. where she was the Asst. Band Director. She then took the position of Director of Bands in the Licking Valley School District where she currently teaches Elementary Music. She has studied tuba with Robert LeBlanc and Jim Akins, and conducting with Craig Kirchhoff, Harvey Benstein, Dr. William Schlacks, and Dr. Russel Mikkelson.

Schmelzer Bock has been a member of the 122nd Army Band/Army National Guard stationed at Beitler Armory in Worthington, OH. She currently plays tuba with the Heisey Wind Ensemble, Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, TBDBITL Alumni Band and Alumni Sousa's, and the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

When not involved in music, she enjoys sewing, home improvement, and traveling with her husband Jim and her two teen children Christopher and LeeAnn
