Jeffrey L. Roquemore

Artistic Director

Retired after serving 16 years at Zanesville High School as band director and music department coordinator from 1988-2004. At ZHS, Jeff was in charge of the concert band, wind ensemble, jazz band and pep band in addition to the marching band, which had an unbroken record of 16 appearances at state finals. Previously Jeff held band director positions at Philo HS, Hamlin (WVA) HS, and Fort Frye HS. Earned Bachelors Degree at Ohio University in 1974, Masters Degree in Music Education at Marshall University in 1981, and a Masters Degree in Public School Administration at Ohio University in 1992. He has served the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) in many capacities, having held district offices of secretary/treasurer, president-elect, and president; hosting high school large group, middle school solo & ensemble, regional orchestra, local marching band, and district honor band/choir events. His professional organizations include OMEA, American School Band Directors Association, Phi Beta Mu, Omicron Delta Kappa, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Jeff was director of the Muskingum College Spirit Band 2004-2006, and currently directs the Coshocton County Community Band. He resides in Dresden with his wife, Jennifer.

Amanda Blevins – Conductor 2008 ZMCB Honors Band

Amanda G. Blevins, in her 14th year of teaching, began her career at Bishop Watterson High School in Columbus, Ohio. She has been teaching music at Tri-Valley Local Schools since 1996. She is in her 13th year as a performing member of the Heisey Wind Ensemble at Denison University. This group performs five concerts a year and has been selected twice to perform at the OMEA State Convention. Ms. Blevins is a certified Pathwise Mentor and Praxis III Assessor for entry year teachers through the Ohio Department of Education. She has served as a writer for the Ohio Fine Arts Curriculum Model Team. In the past she has worked with other music and arts teachers to develop the Muskingum County Fine Arts Course of Study. She is currently a National Board Certified Teacher for music education. This past February she presented her “Integrated Arts Concert Project” at the OMEA State Convention in Cincinnati and has been asked to be a presenter at the Capital University Directors Workshop in June 2008. In 2006 she was honored as the Wal-Mart Teacher of the Year. Under her direction at Tri-Valley, the high school and junior high bands have obtained Superior Ratings at OMEA District and State Marching Competitions and OMEA District Concert Band Contest. The symphonic band was invited to the OSU Wind Band Invitational this past February. The Marching Scotties have competed nationally in the Bands of America competition at Disney World in Florida. The Tri-Valley Bands have hosted the German Big Band from Rhine Germany on three occasions.
